

2014 Two Moors Two Seas tour – Sunday Meeting

The one-liner: “Meet 11am at Barbrook on the A39”

In a little more detail....

The quickest route to Barbrook is to take the A361 along the south of Exmoor and then turn right and go north up the A399 after South Moulton. If you are not driving, you get lovely views of Exmoor on your right as the road winds and climbs upwards. Eventually, you enter Barbrook and you have two options:

<p>1. Either turn left at the junction with a garage on your right. You then see the view as shown in the picture opposite.</p> <p>Down this road is an Exmoor information building on the right, just past a bay with space for 4 cars.</p> <p>If you carry on down this road then there is parking by the side of the road, on your right.</p>	
<p>2. Or go straight on and park along the left hand side as shown in the picture opposite:</p>	
<p>The meeting point is the information building shown in the photographs below. There is a sheltered area in the middle with a washroom on the left and an information office on the right.</p>	
	
<p>If you are just dropping off walkers here and you would like to see Lynmouth then carry on down the road past the information office. There are car parks in Lynmouth but beware, it does get very busy.</p>	

Please note that you must make your own decisions as to where to leave your car. The organisers of the walk cannot take any responsibility for this.
